<b>Summary:</b> (machine translated) Open tour with 2 high abseiling points as a highlight (40m + 60m). Great views of the Drau Valley and the last two waterfalls of the Frauenbach opposite. The entire tour is wooded and offers a good alternative if other canyons carry too much water. Catchment area approx. 2.6km2. Many emergency exits.		
<b>Hydrology:</b>		
<b>Access:</b> (machine translated) Drive from Lienz in the direction of Carinthia. Shortly before the airfield, turn left off the B100 and drive to Lengberg. In Lengberg take the road up to Lengberg Castle, behind it there is a large parking lot (46.797336, 12.892346).		
<b>Approach:</b> (machine translated) From the parking lot either along the road or the Fortsweg up to the Trutschnig farm. From here, continue along the gravel road to a meadow. Leave the road and walk along the lower edge of the meadow to the forest. Just above the edge of the forest, a path that is initially difficult to see leads down to the stream, with the entry point at the first waterfall about 50m below.		
<b>Tour:</b> (machine translated) This tour is not incised, but offers two very high waterfalls. The high waterfall can be rappelled with a ropeway to the left (spruce) with approx. 45m of ropes. The entire canyon is wooded and very slippery. As this tour is not at risk of flooding, it can also be done during rainfall.		
<b>Return:</b> (machine translated) Descend along the streambed until you reach a small dam. There turn right, approx. 10m, onto the hiking trail. From there, follow the signs back to the end of Lengberg.
