Beautiful and simple canyon in the Natural Monument of the Riscos de Tirajana, dry and with the possibility of making it circular, even linking with Culogallina or Negro in the same day.

Situation bcos Negro, Meca, Perro, Culogalina, Quebrada y Magaz

Possibility of two vehicles, the one of return we would leave it in the GC60, in the pk 15,1, next to there is a recurve with some stones and space to park.

With the access vehicle we will go to Ayacata, to the pk 14,3, to locate the detour to the right by the GC600 to Roque Nublo, just in the pk 9 we have a place where to park.

By the path that goes to the south, to the cut of the Hornos. We will follow the path heading south with the Negro bank on the left and about 500m after the cut we turn right to the Ventana del Nublo, a beautiful natural stone arch that is a fantastic viewpoint. From here we head S-SW another 500m to find a crevasse that becomes a crevasse through which to descend to the first rapell.

After the last rapell we turn left under the rock walls to go to take a track a few meters below that will take us to the road.

If we only have one vehicle we will turn right through the valley, there are remains/traces of trails that will go up the slope always following the dry riverbed that leads to the pass next to the Ventano. Once there we only have to retrace the access road.
