Beautiful rappel canyon with slides and possible jumps. The highlight is the 50m high, free-hanging waterfall.

Hydrology:

Access: (machine translated)

From Taibon Agordino, head west on Via S. Lucano to Col di Prà.

Approach: (machine translated)

From the parking lot, follow hiking trail no. 761 on the orographic right side steeply upwards until it leads to the forest road (no. 762 to C.ra Malgonera). Continue upwards to the confluence of 3 streams. Cross the Torrente Bordina and enter the Val Malgonera at approx. 1200m.

Tour: (machine translated)

Start in Val Malgonera with a rope traverse (approx. 10m) to the first rappel orographic right (approx. 20m), followed by 2 slides. Then climb under the bridge to the next belay (right), rappel approx. 10m to a handrail on the left. From there rappel approx. 20m (confluence with the Torrente Bordina). Then follow several smaller steps and rappels to the "Cascata dell inferno" (rope traverse and belay on the left). Either get out here and follow the path to the parking lot, or continue along the streambed to the forest path/parking lot (3 more waterfalls, block climbing).

Beautiful abseiling points in the watercourse. Top equipped stands (glued anchors, chain anchors; some rope traverses). Tour is commercially guided. At the 50m rappel (the actual "Cascata dell Inferno"), an orographic ropeway can be set up at the bottom right, then you can rappel through the waterfall. Afterwards you can either exit via the path or take 2-3 more abseils (one of which is difficult to access/very slippery!). We started at approx. 1350m, but this part up to 1200m is not worthwhile, lots of sliding. (machine translated)
