Hydrology:

Take the B71 from Mariazell in the direction of Lunz am See. Park about 1 km after the parking lot of Taglesbach at a wooden bridge over the Ois.

Approach: (machine translated)

Follow the marked trail no. 17 until you reach a forest road with an evenly steep incline. Follow this road until a forest road branches off to the right - follow this road to the bridge over the Eisgraben.

Tour: (machine translated)

Oftentimes old slings at the rappelling points, carry enough spare material.

Hike via forest road parallel to the Ois back to the parking lot.
