Drive up the Vésubie valley and just before Lantosque, turn right onto the D2565 towards St Colomban. Drive 600 m and park near the bridge over the Vésubie.

**Approach:** (machine translated)

Continue along this road on the D bank of the Vesubie for 600 m and take the first bridge over the Riou.

**Tour:** (machine translated)

Attack at the level of the via ferrata's starting platform, rappel 15 meters to gain a foothold in the canyon.

A T7 and then the beautiful 20-meter abseil that leads directly into the Vésubie. The route continues more or less floating depending on the water level.

Length of the route: 215 m for the Riou de Lantosque + 330 m for the Vésubie.

Do not start with a large volume of water in the Vésubie, which is very deep in this part. The flow of the Riou will therefore be modest.

To be done from June to October as a complement to another in the valley.
