Summary: (machine translated)

Open hike and rappel canyon in Sinter.

Also known as Rio Abellio.

Hydrology:

Access: (machine translated)

Either from Ventimiglia on the SS 20 in the direction of Breil-sur-Roya, Tende, Cuneo and after about 12 km, immediately after a long tunnel turn right in the direction of Airole or coming from the north (Breil-sur-Roya) after 13 km (from Breil) immediately before the tunnel and the road bridge over the Roya turn left in the direction of Airole. However, we do not drive at the first houses left up into the village, but straight ahead on the old SS 20 and come (first left transformer station(?), then a - usually open - barrier) about a good 1.5 km after the turn from the new SS 20 to the road bridge over "our" stream. Directly behind it the railroad bridge. Here we park the car at a suitable place. There is no barrier anymore. Ignore the dead end sign. Up to the parking lot one comes through. We did not look further. 2 parking spaces for cars are at the edge of the road.

Approach: (machine translated)

In the map from Airole marked in red "2": Back on the road; immediately after the transformer station, up the small road on the right to the central square (church on the left and fountain in the middle) in Airole. From here, head east up the road with the stair-like flat steps (signposts "Rocchetta" and "Basse d'Abellio"). We are now on the "Sentiero 1" on the internet map. Soon we go right at a first signpost, 10 min. later left at another junction, always following the white-red markings.\nThe path now walks in the direction of OSE towards Vall Para, then turns east and after a few hundred meters high above Valle Para we come to Torrente Careghin, where we enter.

Tour: (machine translated)

Actually a pure "children's" canyon to get used to canyoning. Valle Para does not have the attractiveness of Audin, but as a whole package (with scenic) is somewhat better than the neighboring Montixi to the north. Mostly low water flow, but water clear. Some jumps up to 7m possible.

No obvious emergency exits, but you can get out sideways.

Return: (machine translated)

After passing under the railroad bridge, left out to the road and the car.
