Summary: (machine translated) Short, but very beautiful, incised canyon. Alternative canyon after rainfall.		
Hydrology:		
Access: (machine translated) Drive from Absam in the direction of Andreas-Hofer-Kaserne. Parking is available at the Absam sports club and tennis club.		
Approach: (machine translated) Follow the asphalt road from the tennis club (Gspreidach). At the first bend, follow a path upwards until you come to a gravel track. From here, follow the forest road briefly downhill again until another steep path branches off to the right. Follow this to the Buchtaler Hütte (entry directly behind it).		
Tour:		
Return: (machine translated) After the last rappel, follow the stream and then the gravel path to the forest path. Then take the access path back to the parking lot.

Possible plan B when it has rained a lot. Most gravel is diverted into a neighbour gully. Solid compact rock. Home to local gemse. Unfortunately the canyon is too short. Done with e-bike partially.

Water level increased after several days of (heavy) rain (snowfall from 1200 m). Full neoprene required! Anchor points are all okay, even if there is room for improvement in terms of rope friction. Unfortunately, the tour comes at the price of a much too long approach and an equally long return. You climb a good 300 vertical meters to the exit and logically also descend again afterwards. All the water actually seeps away in the wide gravel bed on the way back. (machine translated)
