Access: (machine translated)

From Bregenz via Alberschwende to Mellau. Past Schnepfau, before reaching the edge of the forest, turn left onto the road that would lead back to Schnepfau into the village. But we turn right after a few meters onto the dirt road and park the car before the bridge.

Approach: (machine translated)

We follow the dirt road further into the forest. We cross a quarry. The track goes up in serpentines. We reach our forest gorge, the forest road now goes flat for a few meters. Then a track goes off to the right, which we follow to the streambed (beyond the stream wildlife feeding).

Tour: (machine translated)

At the beginning, diagonal ropes in open terrain. The key points are then a 40 m high waterfall (breaking possible before the edge: 12 m/30 m), as well as the 35 m high, somewhat winding final waterfall (breaking 15 m/20 m makes sense; the last 20 m can also be rappelled on dry ground following the wire rope handrail). The canyon may still be accessible if most of the other streams in the Bregenzerwald are carrying too much water. It is also used commercially.

Return: (machine translated)

After the final waterfall, which you may already know from visiting, out to the old road. On this right (northward) to the new road and next to this back to the car.
