Dry, simple ravine that flows into Capellanes and that we can continue to the Júcar.

Access Jalance area

We must be located in Jalance by the N330.

Access Bcos Jalance

Entering from the side of Requena by the old national road we will arrive inside the village at a sharp left turn where we have the detour to the right towards the Cueva de Don Juan and the Mirador de los Cañones del Júcar. We will follow the signs to the Cueva de Don Juan as we leave the village.

Once out of the village we will reach a sharp right turn with a road ahead (Cueva de Don Juan).

We will go through some hairpin bends through which we will climb to the top. One kilometer later, through the crop fields, we will have a detour. To the right we will go to the Cave and the Mirador, parking Alejo Gómez, Largo, Capellanes, Robles and Useros. On the left 6kms we would go to the Moragete.

After the viewpoint, after 1 km the road goes to the cave, we will be attentive to a sharp left turn to take the track that goes straight ahead, the first river that crosses is Capellanes, the second Robles and soon we will see some crops and the Casa Useros. We park in Robles and if we have two cars we can leave the second one in Useros to save a few minutes of return.

Approach: (machine translated)

Bcos (left to right) Carrasca, Useros, Robles, Capellanes, Largo, Alejo Gómez

It is obvious, you just have to go down to the riverbed

Tour: (machine translated)

Simple. From Bco Capellanes it closes and narrows, gaining height rappels. Capellanes is equipped with clamps as a ferrata except for the final part.

Return: (machine translated)

Leaving the ropes to climb them or going up the Capellanes clamps.

Or when we get to the Júcar we turn left to the trail that goes up to Casa Useros.

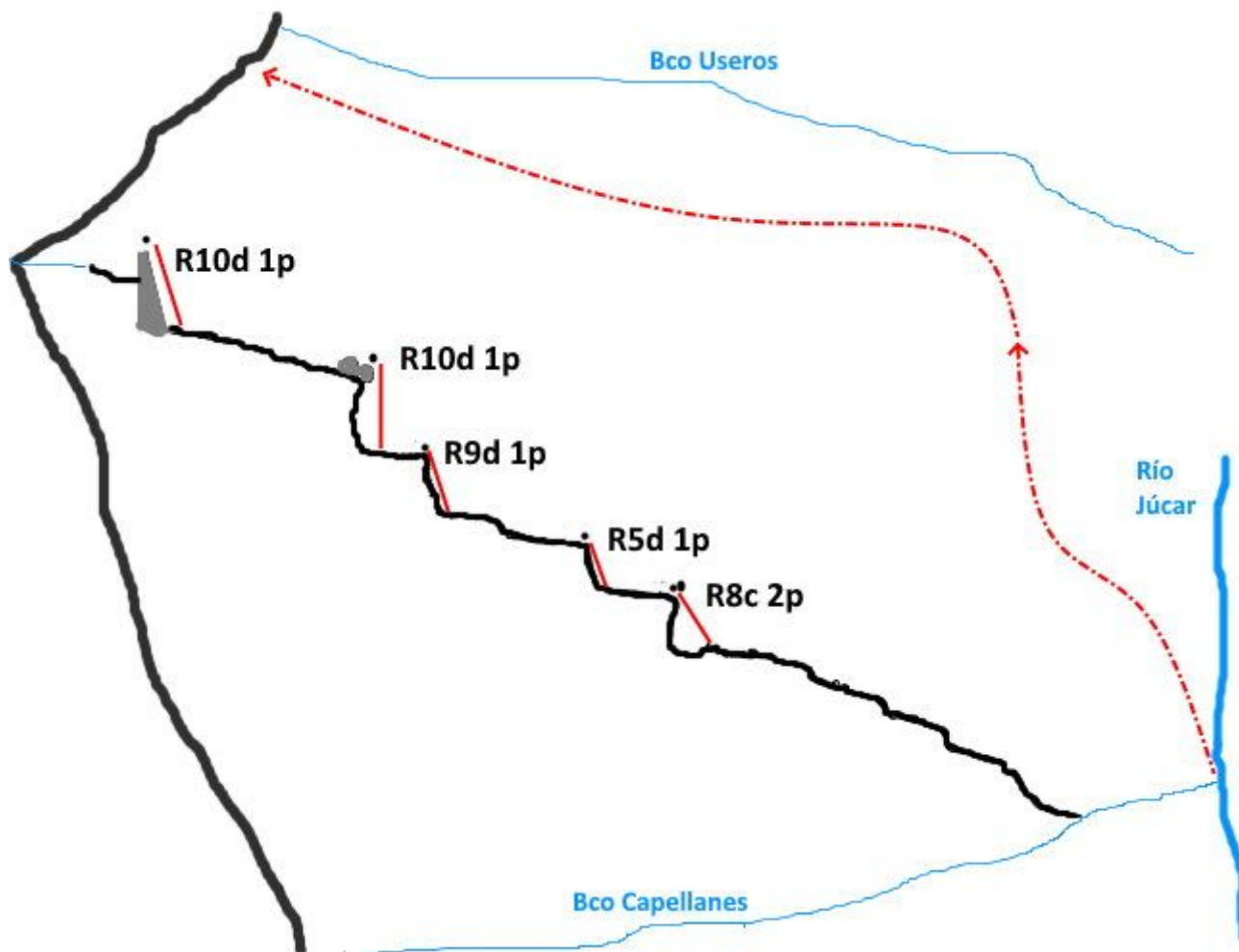
