Vertical rappel canyon that carries water only after heavy rains or during snowmelt.

Access: (machine translated)

We leave the highway - coming from Cagliari - at the Sanluri exit and take the SS197 west. We pass San Gavino Monreale and then turn left on the SP4 to Gonnosfanadiga. We pass through the town and head southwest towards the "Parco Communale Perd'e de Pibera". About 2.5 km after leaving the town, we come to a concrete bridge that leaves to the right over the Riu Piras. Continuing on the "main road", after a few meters we come to a dirt road that goes off to the right. Depending on the condition of the road and the robustness of our car, it makes sense to park it here instead of continuing on the road for another 500m (see Google-map in "photo gallery").

Approach: (machine translated)

So we go first on the slope, then the subsequent hiking trail "102" up to the saddle "Genna Eidadi" at 1026m altitude. We follow the path for a short distance, then we leave it to climb up to the ridge through a hollow on the left. From here we go essentially horizontally under the ridge descending from Punta Cammedda in a northeasterly direction. In doing so, we can stay below a contour line of 1050m. We pass 3 larger cirques and then in the fourth smaller cirque we come to the starting point of our descent. Tour: (machine translated)

The route in the Gole d Punta Cammedda is a succession of about 10 fairly vertical rappels, mostly with a respective length between 25 and 35 meters. In between, one is busy downclimbing. Often the rappeling is done from trees.
