Summary: (machine translated) Beautiful short aquatic lime canyon; some jumping and slides; fresh clean water; southwest exposure; can be combined with Rio Lomming.		
Hydrology:		
Access: (machine translated) The village of Resutta lies between Chiusaforte and Carnia. From here you drive into the beautiful Resia Valley. Follow the road signposted "Stolvizza" and "Coritis". After the village of Stolvizza, the road first leads downhill. You cross the T. Resia (follow the signs for "Coritis"). The road then climbs up some narrow hairpin bends to a chapel. From here, the road leads slightly downhill again. After approx. 2.2 km from the chapel, you cross two small road bridges (R. Slatina and T. Resia) in quick succession. Immediately after the second bridge, follow the forest road left downhill for 400m to the very back of the trail (Caution! You cross 2 stream crossings and therefore need some ground clearance). At the end (after the 2nd crossing) the forest road bends to the right. You can either park your car here or follow the forest road uphill for approx. 100m and park your car directly at the hiking trail signpost 657 (entry/exit parking lot). (P.s. It is 9km from the sign at the end of Resutta to Stolvizza and 4.4km from Stolvizza to the two small bridges).		
Approach: (machine translated) From the parking lot directly at the hiking signpost 657 ("Birio Sant", "Sella Grubia"), follow the path orographic to the right of the stream. At the wooden plaque with the depicted bird, the hiking trail leads upwards. Follow this for approx. 140m until an inconspicuous path branches off to the right (marked path goes to the left. On the right is a dry streambed). Follow the path next to the gorge until you reach a gravel slope (2 red dots). Then follow/descend the steep gravel slope over red dots to the streambed. Entry at approx. 670m.		
Tour: (machine translated) The access is not easy and rather long in relation to the tour. Nevertheless, the Rio Ronc is a worthwhile canyon. Especially those who like to slide and jump will get their money's worth. After a short section of walking, the first 2 abseiling points are reached; 3m and 20m. The 20m step is also the highest point. Most of the following steps can be slid or jumped, depending on the water level. Between the steps, there are always short walking passages with beautiful washouts. The tour exits at the access path at approx. 600m.		
Return: (machine translated) Climb out of the stream to the right onto the access path and shortly back to the parking lot.
