Summary: The "Turcinu Mare" Canyon is a technical canyon with a considerable flow. The tallest waterfall is 65 m, and navigating it in high water conditions is a real challenge.		
Hydrology: You cannot judge the flow from the lower parking, a water pipe takes almost all the water 2/3 of the way down. You have to do the walk in to see the flow.		
Access: 5km shuttle on a bad gravel road, needs a SUV.		
Approach: Long uphill hike (with lovely views higher up) and long approach along a tree strewn river bed.		
Tour: A beautiful central waterfall, where it is important to find the re-belay - well to the side on river left. All the water disappears 2/3 of the way down into a water pipe.		
Return: Immediate. Final waterfall ends by the road.
