Simple canyon, of initiation, almost always dry except for heavy rains. The months of January and February is usually completely frozen.

Hydrology:

Access: (machine translated)

Along the CM210 that goes from Molina de Aragón almost to Cuenca, crossing the Alto Tajo in an area of great ecological value. Right next to Beteta, at pk 50, if we go towards Beteta (from Puente Vadillos), after the curve to the left, we have a small lay-by on the right next to the dam. We park

Approach: (machine translated)

We cross the Guadiela and we will see a small path that takes us out of the canyon in which we are. Once the climb is done (less than 100m) continues gently to the south-southeast, entering the valley of our stream. When we are almost 1km from the car we will enter the stream bed.

Tour: (machine translated)

Simple, a couple of descents to reach the two verticals (28 and 23m respectively) before reaching the confluence with the Guadiela.

Return: (machine translated)

We have two options:

* Cross the river and climb the embankment to the road. Then we will walk to the siding.

* If we see it with too much flow or do not want to cross, we can go along the bank to the dam to cross there, but there is no clear path and too much vegetation.

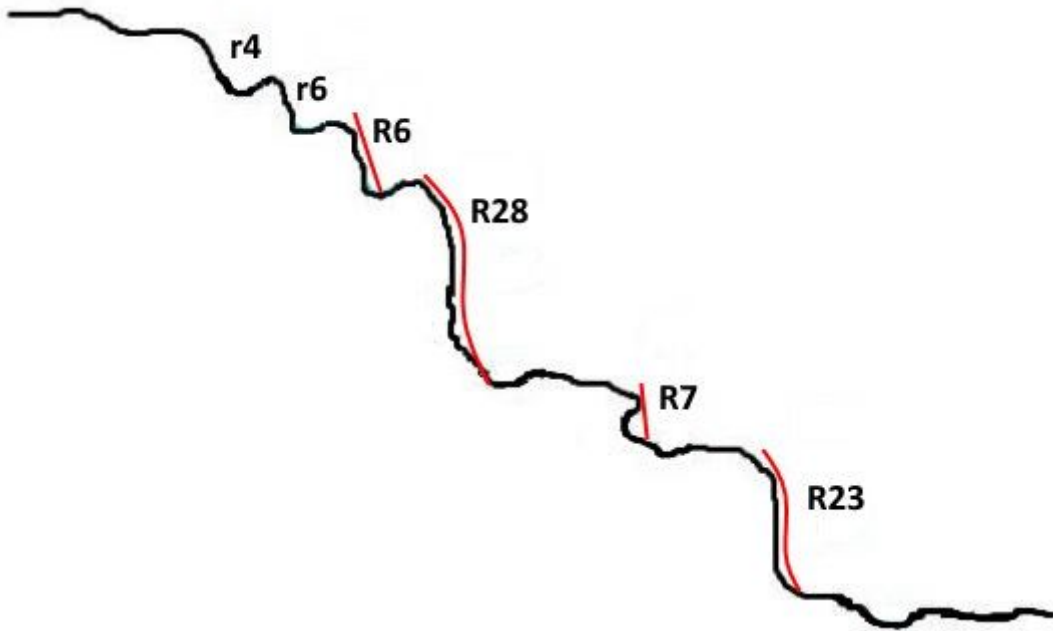
