take a flat path to the left that is not always clearly visible. You will pass a

first abandoned hut and reach two more huts with a small chapel.

and then paths up again. When it becomes flat again,

approach the streambed and continue to an open area.

area. Here the path disappears; the entrance is at a large boulder in the middle of the stream.

the boulder or better downstream with an abseil point at natural anchors.
