Summary: (machine translated) Nice, not difficult tour in sunny, open ditch. Access perfectly combinable with the cozy, beautifully built gorge via ferrata. Scenic, well suited for beginners.		
Hydrology:		
Access: (machine translated) After Klebas on the main road in Lesachtal. Turn off towards Tscheltsch, then to Ladstatt. Then go under the town bridge of the farm and up the gravel road on the left. At the access road, simply follow the signs for "Klettersteig Millnatzenklamm". The parking lot has been subject to charges since 2015.		
Approach: (machine translated) After the barrier you come to an overview board. From here, access via the Millnatzen via ferrata is highly recommended: difficulty C, two short, more challenging sections, but overall stress-free with full canyoning equipment (including via ferrata set!). Access to the via ferrata 15 min; via ferrata 60-80 min. Millnatzenklamm via ferrata at http://www.bergsteigen.com/klettersteig/kaernten/gailtaler-alpen-lienzer-dolomiten/millnatzenklamm-klettersteig . Alternatively, it is possible to take the descent route of the via ferrata orig. right from the overview board (approx. 25 min).		
Tour: (machine translated) The route starts directly at the via ferrata exit sign. Emergency exit to the via ferrata but also from the canyon itself is always possible. The water flow is leisurely but appealing, but apart from the C30 it is actually avoidable if not desired. Sunny tour in beautiful scenic surroundings with many canyon voyeurs when the via ferrata is well frequented. Most of the route is equipped with chain anchors and 14 numbered emergency plaques. Places that can also be downclimbed are equipped with a neatly placed anchor. The highest abseil point is an honest 30m (my 55-meter rope was a full 5m too short).		
Return: (machine translated) After the last rappel point, go around the next bend in the stream and turn right onto the access path to the via ferrata.
