<b>Summary:</b> (machine translated) Short canyon with an abseil of almost 60m and little more, perfect to combine with any other in the Falgars area where its cuts offer several possibilities. If we catch it after rains is a great experience because its rappel by the asset of the waterfall is fantastic.		
<b>Hydrology:</b>		
<b>Access:</b> (machine translated) Location Val d'en Bas We must be located in Falgars d'en Bas. From San Esteve d'en Bas on the C153 southbound, we turn off at Els Hortalets, cross the village and go southbound on the local road. After 500m we have the detour to the right to La Coromina/Falgars. We will go up to Falgars and park. If we go from the south from Rupit on the C153, at pk 34 we have a curve where the detour to Falgars. If we have two cars, we will leave the return car at Els Hortalets.		
<b>Approach:</b> (machine translated) Val d'en Bas ravines From Falgars leaving by the local road to the north we have the detour to the left of the track to Freixadella, we will pass a first stream that is usually dry (Bco Freixadella) where there is a rural house with swimming pool, we continue along the track next to the cut, the next stream is Batllia and the third is ours.		
<b>Tour:</b> (machine translated) Vertical descent, a few small slopes to get closer to the 60m vertical, another one to finish the waterfall, and then small slopes through the forest.		
<b>Return:</b> (machine translated) We follow the course and we have to get to see a small path on the right that leads us to the uphill track. If we do not see it we will find a second clearer path much further down. If we have two cars we can continue along the river towards the village or leave the same way to go down the track.
