The steepness of the descent and the surrounding area require considerable effort.

Often low flow, even zero in summer. Can be climbed in wet seasons. However, caution should be exercised when passing through the large vertical section.

Access: (machine translated)

From Grenoble, take the Route de l'Oisans (D1091), turn off at the Les Vernes hydroelectric power station and head towards Livet.

After the bridge over the Romanche, turn left, drive past the wash house, take the Chemin de Fontario, turn left again and park in the La Renardière parking lot.

Approach: (machine translated)

From the parking lot, take the asphalt path "Chemin des Sources" (the IGN path no longer exists). After 300 m, at the hydrant, take the path on the left. The path climbs steeply. You will pass a first stream with little water. The stream you are heading for is easy to recognize, as it consists of rock slabs and offers a beautiful view of the valley.

Tour: (machine translated)

Start on AN RD, and you soon come across a number of good pieces of equipment from 2016. The large waterfall in the chute is divided into RGs halfway up. On the whole, the equipment is logical and well thought out: the points are where you expect them to be.

Approach: Don't forget your hazelnut sticks!

Return: (machine translated)

When you arrive in the forest, you will find an RG path that leads under the high-voltage power line and takes you back to the parking lot.
