Summary: (machine translated) Little incised valley, but pleasant to walk through		
Hydrology: (machine translated) The valley is mostly dry and only filled with water after rainfall.		
Access: (machine translated) From Vence, take the D2210 road in the direction of Grasse. In Tourrettes-sur-Loup, opposite the Grand-Place, take the small road up past the post office and then the St-Jean chapel. Park in the Bastide aux Violettes parking lot. If there is no space available, leave the parking lot and turn right to park on the bank of the stream, the end point of the descent, without obstructing others.		
Approach: (machine translated) From the parking lot, follow the road that crosses the stream and, after 200 m, turn right onto Chemin de St Martin, which you follow for 700 m before turning right onto Chemin du Villars and climbing up to its exit, a dead end (25 min.). From there, follow the yellow-marked PR trail, which winds its way and offers panoramic views as far as the sea, from the Plaine du Var to the Esterel. When the path leads to a flat clearing (rusty barrel - 55 min), take the path that goes uphill for 60 m and then turn right (follow the blue dots) onto another path that goes downhill for 100 m. Leave this path again on the right onto another path, which you follow to the turning point (1 hr. 10 min.). From this loop, a path leads over the blue dots to the stream (1:15 hrs).		
Tour: (machine translated) Not very incised valley, but pleasant to walk along. 4 waterfalls C6 max on natural rocks, then a walk and descent leads to waterfall C19 (chain) whose rappel ends in a spider web (cave at the base); then C10. From there the stream narrows through C6 & C5 before C12 in a narrow corridor (rappel through strong current), followed by a C6. You reach the largest waterfall of the descent, the C22 with a pool with well-rounded edges, then a C8. A 50 m long footpath precedes the two C5s with pools. As the banks are private land, it is essential to stay in the riverbed (200 m under the reeds) until you reach the bridge. After the bridge, you will find the car on the left. Access via the Cairo road, which is closed to traffic, is not interesting as there are no obstacles before the starting point described above.		

Return: (machine translated)

1st solution: Leave the bridge directly, there is no possibility of turning back.

2nd solution: After the parking lot bridge, you can continue to descend the last waterfall (C20 AN RD, clearly visible from the road when you leave Tourrettes), the exit on the same road being quite "wild" but fast. To return to the car, follow the road that runs between the rocks and leads back to the village; at the entrance to the village, turn left to pass the post office and the St-Jean chapel again (10 min.).

3rd option: you can continue along the valley of Pascaressa (secateurs useful) after passing under the road and cross 4 pools with jumps and swims to leave the site opposite the purification plant. Follow the path on the left that leads up to the village (20 min.). You can also take a shuttle bus by leaving the vehicle near the old train station (5 min ride).
