We will cross the village in search of the signs of the Airón well, it is the street of the church on the left. We will go down the track to the parking lot.

We will follow the path for almost one kilometer to get into the riverbed just before the waterfall.

Missing meeting in the first rappel, it descends from single point in the active, with more flow difficult to access the single point.
