Summary: (machine translated) Commercially used short forest gorge parallel to the Palfauer Wasserloch. There is also supposed to be an upper part, but it is not commercially accessible.		
Hydrology:		
Access: (machine translated) From Landl via the B24 into the Salzatal. Large parking lot at the Wasserlochschenke		
Approach: (machine translated) Take the paid path over the suspension bridge, then continue to a fork in the path, right to the Palfauer Wasserloch, left to the Jägerriedel. We take the path to the Jägerriedel, cross the stream from the waterhole and climb about 90m until a clear path leads to the left into the Reichergraben. Entry at the stream.		
Tour: (machine translated) Small slides and rappels up to 20m in an open forest gorge.		
Return: (machine translated) Exit to the left and return to the access path via the footpaths on the orographic right bank of the Salz. If you feel confident enough to cross the Salza, you can get off 100m downstream at the Schönauf landing stage and walk back via the main road.
