Summary: (machine translated) Open canyon with some high abseils. Thanks to many escape routes and few water/rope difficulties, it is also suitable for beginners, but you should bear in mind that there is a weir above the canyon. Popular and often climbed.		
Hydrology: (machine translated) ATTENTION! FLOOD WAVE ! After prolonged and heavy rain, the automatic flap in the Wienerbruck dam may open! It is essential to check before the tour whether the water level is approx. 1.5m below the flap (recommendation from a power station employee), or call the power station directly. Access: (machine translated) Coming from Mariazell take the main road in the direction of St. Pölten until you reach Wienerbruck. In the village drive to the parking lot at the reservoir (signs: Ötschergräben).		
Approach: (machine translated) Follow the hiking trail in the direction of Lassingfall until you reach the confluence of a water-bearing ditch from the left (the canyon turns east here). In this ditch quite steeply up until you meet a forest road, which you follow in an easterly direction. At a fork, follow the forest road leading down to the entry in the Kienbach. \nIf you want to do without the rappel in the Kienbach, stay on the marked hiking trail for a bit to descend above a 4m jump into the streambed.		
Tour: (machine translated) At the Kienbach 2 rappel (10m, 25m), secured with tree slings. In the Lassingfall then another beautiful 5m possible jumps before the long abseil begins after the bridge of the hiking trail. Due to the sunny location, the rock is partly very slippery. The last big step can be done with one rappel (70m) or two rappels (40m, 25m). The belaystation for the second variant is located on the sloping slabs to the right of the waterfall (be careful in case of rain) \nThe tour ends with a 3m jump at the bridge before the exit into the Erlauf.		
Return: (machine translated) Follow the hiking trail along the Lassingfall to the parking lot.
