Summary:

In the upper part, short gorges alternate with hiking passages, while the lower part with little water leads through a very beautiful narrow gorge.

A commercially popular slide and rappel canyon

Hydrology:

Access:

From Bled follow road 209 until about one kilometer before Bohinjska Bistrica, here turn right onto the road to Jereka. Before reaching the church of Jereka, turn left and follow the road uphill until you reach a paid parking lot under a small quarry.

Approach:

If you only want to walk the lower part of the canyon, follow the forest road from the parking lot into the valley, cross the mostly dry streambed and climb another 50 m until the forest road meets the stream again at a dam with a water drain.

If you want to walk the entire canyon, continue up the forest road, which becomes increasingly steeper and overgrown. After about 15 minutes you come to a crossing path which you follow back into the canyon to the left. Entry here. It is probably also possible to take a second car to the upper bridge over the Jereka and enter there, or to cross from the leftward hairpin bend below the cluster of houses of Podjelje over alpine meadows into the canyon.

Tour:

Many slides and low rappels up to max. 15m in a gorge that is wonderfully washed out in sections.

Narrow sections alternate with walking passages. Due to many emergency exits and little water flow, it is also doable in bad weather. A rewarding gorge (not only) for beginners. For protection - moderate in the upper part, excellent in the lower part.

Return:

After the rock gate, the gorge suddenly opens and you find a trail on the right bank, which you follow back to the access forest road.
