Approach well steep on animal tracks. When you reach the gravel bank, you can return to the grassy slope on the right bank to ascend to elevation 840 where you begin with a nice rappel on the 35 meters. Weapons recently supplemented by the Claut Water Sport Center, although on the last rappel the placement on the left bank makes rope retrieval tiring and the higher plate does not rest well on the rock.
