Coming from Storo on the SP 69 we go for 3 km in the direction of Baitone-Bondone. After the Km stone 2/VIII (right Moto-Cross) the stream flows under the road. There you can park a car for the return trip directly at the streambed.\nA little further on, a very narrow, paved little road leads up the mountain on the left in many narrow turns. After a good 2 km you have reached a bridge, where you look for a suitable place for the upper car.

Reinstated one original line in the active (on a granite boulder instead of the cracked rock of the other line), but most anchors are as said, a mix of rusty chains & webbing on trees.
