Summary: (machine translated) Long, vertical and wild tour in a very remote corner of Friuli		
Hydrology:		
Access: (machine translated) A23 to Osoppo exit, then via San Daniele, Ragona, Pinzano and Sequals to Meduno. From here towards Passo Rest. At a dam turn left over the top of the dam and go through Tamarat and Chievolis. After the second village, take a narrow road high above the canyon of Torrente Silisa until you reach the houses of Selva. Here turn left towards Forcella Clautana. Follow the narrow, mostly asphalted road until it gets close to the streambed again for the first time. Here you can park 5 cars.		
Approach: (machine translated) Descend the slope and cross the Torrente Silisia. Climb up to the mouth of the Silisia and our stream and follow an indistinct path along the ridge to a renovated house (Stua) (you can also reach here via a second path that starts about 300m upstream at a leaning piece of corrugated iron). Behind the house, first flat then briefly steep to a serpentine path which you follow to the ruins of Pecolat. Behind the ruins, take a former mule track that leads across and follow this initially without gaining height. Climb up to the right at two junctions, then climb up very steeply and on a barely recognizable path to a flattening in the ridge (ruins of a cable car station). Follow the narrow ridge until it splits again, then branch off to the right onto an indistinct path. Shortly through the bushes, then cross very exposed above a rock face (dangerous when wet). Cross the path ascending over tracks, always with beautiful views of the large Fontanon del Tasseit waterfall (the path is somewhat visible in the forest, ascend on the meadow ribs if in doubt until you can cross to the right again). Descend into a nameless side valley and descend over scree and cut-out mountain pine steps to the streambed. Cross the stream and on the other bank on a very indistinct path up to a watercourse from the right (large cave entrance above on the other bank). Climb very steeply to the right of the side stream over grassy slopes, then keep right (climbing tracks) up to a small forest saddle. Climb another 50m very steeply up to another flattened ridge and descend eastwards at a small beech tree with a carved 'font' into a gorge-like streambed (the only way to cross this streambed). Climb up briefly on the other side and keep just below the rock faces until you reach the start of the tour at a karst spring (Risorgiva del Randonneur).		

Tour: (machine translated)

First 4 abseils to 30m from trees, then two abseils in narrow gorge from bolts before facing the big waterfall. Abseil sequence: 10m from tree right, 40m from chain left. 75m from chain left (can also be divided into 25m and 50m, hanging position). Then 5 rappels in narrow canyon before the previously crossed side creek with a sloping 80m+ waterfall coming in from the right. After longer walking passages with a few diving pools, nice 25m rappel from the right. Further- walking and downclimb to a 5m rappel followed by a three meter rappel. The canyon ends with a 13m jump (abseilable and repeatable) and a 5m jump into a fairly shallow pool (abseilable on the right).

Return: (machine translated)

Through the streambed back to the parking lot
