Minor ravine, 3 rappels without more, nice with water but to combine with some more in the area.

Hydrology:

Access: (machine translated)
From Burgohondo or Mijares going up the Pto de Mijares.
Location of Majadas Viejas, Chorros and Navalayegua ravine.
We will pass the pass and descend towards Villanueva de Ávila. We will be able to park after km. 10, on the left curve, at the end of which there is a place on the left.
If we also want to do Navalayegua we can park by taking the track 300m before on the left.

Approach: (machine translated)
Access to Chorros and Navalayegua ravine
Almost immediate access, from before the curve we go out on the right to go down to the riverbed.

3 rappels

Return: (machine translated)
After the third waterfall we reach the remains of a path, we can take it to the left to go to the Hoyuelas track and climb up there to the road. Or, since it does not descend much, we can go up by machete on the orographic left, to the road.
