<b>Access:</b> (machine translated) Location of Gavarnie From Tarbes we head towards Lourdes on the N21. Then continue towards Gavarnie-Gedre on the D821. Continue towards Gavarnie-Gedre on the D921 to Gèdre and from there to Gavarnie. Almost at the entrance of the village we have a detour to the right towards the slopes. We take it and park the car here. The car park is payable in Gavarnie.		
<b>Approach:</b> (machine translated) We take the road to the cirque and soon we turn left towards the Refuge de Espuguettes. Passing through Pailla we will see the path of Rochers Blancs we take it and follow this path to the foot of the small Astazou. We continue south towards the bottom of the cirque to find a large block from which the descent begins.		
<b>Tour:</b> (machine translated) Very vertical descent with 14 rappels between 25 and 45 meters. Provide equipment for re-equipping or for naturalists.
