Aquatic (at least in the spring) rappel canyon.

Hydrology:

Access: (machine translated)

From the northernmost Greek ferry port (Adriatic Sea) Igoumenitsa, take the N-06 (= E-90) in the direction of Ioannina (95 km). 5 km before the city turn left via Eleousa onto the northbound N-20 (= E-90) and drive about 30 km in the direction of Konitsa. 4.7 km after Kalpaki turn right towards Mesovouni, Aristi. Once there, we take the road to the village of Vikos, which towers high above the canyon of the same name. There we park one car. With the second one we go back to Aristi and there we turn right down to the bridge over the Voidomatis and up to Papingo. At the beginning of the village we turn right up a ridge and go down beyond (30 m). Here park the car at the foot of a wall.

If you have only 1 car, leave it in Papingo and take a path back down from Vikos, crossing Voidomatis and then going up the orographic left slope of Rogovo to Papingo (cf. way back).

Approach: (machine translated)

From here, a terrain depression descends in a southeasterly direction. We follow the path. Maybe there is also the signpost 'To the springs of Voidomatis river'. We reach the wooden footbridge over the stream (entry).

Tour: (machine translated)

25 rappel. Only partly a bit more narrowly cut, exit possibilities to the left (orographic.) up to the mule track (not tested). Difficulty depends on the amount of water, as some rappel 'in the beam'. Since May 2011 apparently now possible to rappel outside the rappel. Barely any opportunity for jumping and slides. Interesting horizontal slab layering.

Return: (machine translated)

There are 3 possibilities: Unless you have a second vehicle, go back up the said mule trail to Papingo. The trail starts a little south (estimated 200 - 300 m) of the Voidomatis (karst) spring. The trail directly from the spring up the boulder field in northeastern direction is only indistinct. The Voidomatis spring is reached by joining the river (Voidomatis) at the exit of Rogovos canyon, following it upwards, crossing it later and heading for the chapel after about 300 m (from the spring to Papingo about a good hour).

The second way back is also first to the chapel, but from there up to the right - first in a southerly direction, until you meet the path coming from the Vikos canyon. Follow it to the right (northwest), up to the village of Vikos, where you should have left the second car before (from the chapel about $\frac{1}{2}$ hour).

The third option is to follow the river Voidomatis downstream at the exit of Rogovo to reach the road bridge (Aristi - Papingo) after about $1\frac{1}{2}$ hours.
