Summary: (machine translated) Rappel canyon with lots of climbing and longer walking passages. Can also be done with just one vehicle.		
Hydrology:		
Access: (machine translated) 11 km northeast of Belluno is Ponte nelle Alpi. Here, south of the road bridge, turn off the SS 51 over the Piave toward Quantin and go up about 9 km to Quantin. Park the upper vehicle in the large parking lot between the church and Rio Maggiore. Park the lower vehicle at the houses of La Secca at the NW exit of Lago di Santa Croce. You can get there on the SS 51 from Ponte nelle Alpi (from the bridge 7 km).		
Approach: (machine translated) From the parking lot in Quantin on the dirt road on the orographic left bank of the Rio Maggiore in a southerly direction, past a washing fountain to the bridge. Get in here (5 min.). There are also several possibilities to get on a little further down, in the area of the most interesting passages. To do this, park at the bridge near Cornolade Alte and hike briefly up a hairpin bend. At the next rightward haipin bend, turn left and take a good path along the edge of the gorge. The first rope-secured descent reaches the gorge just above the large siphon (15 min), but it is well worth following the good climbing tracks about 5 min further uphill to reach the gorge near a closed bridge by means of a 20 m rappel at the beginning of the most interesting part. The paths are marked on the Openstreetmap.		
Tour: (machine translated) Not too deep cut into multi-colored stratified limestone, a lot of downclimbing, many smaller rappels, some possible jumps, 2 siphons whereby the first can be bypassed on the left (anchor for transverse rope available), exit possibility in the middle of the tour at the road bridge, then follows the highest waterfall in the canyon (25m). Caution in the very last section of the gorge after the highway bridge - iron bars in the pools.		

Return: (machine translated)

After crossing under the highway and railroad bridges in the pipe culvert under the SS 51 and right out to the lower vehicle.

There is now a good and easy way to walk back from the exit to the parking lot at Cornolade Alte. From the exit bridge, hike about 400m north along the road towards La Secca. Immediately before crossing the Rio Bars, turn left and walk along an asphalt road under the railroad line. Then ascend briefly and turn right onto a forest path between the two highway bridges. The forest path soon becomes a path that you follow upwards at a pleasant gradient. The path is well trodden and partly marked in red between the gorges of Rio Bars and Rio Maggiore and reaches the viewing platform near the large waterfall of Rio Maggiore after about 25 minutes.

Parked the car at the middle bridge and entered from the 'upper' intermedio entry at the closed bridge. On the first 2 rappels at the top still many annoying trees, then no more problems until just before the end. Lots of jumps and slides possible, but better always check everything. Return on foot, on the road to the north until just before Rio Bars, then turn left onto a private road, and between the two highway bridges turn right onto a forest road which soon becomes a red-marked path. This path between Rio Bars and Val Maggiore is easy to walk and thorn-free and leads back to the middle entry point (machine translated)
