Access: (machine translated) On the TV3421 that goes to Roquetes, just before Mas de Barberáns, in the pk 12,1 we have a detour "La Vall". After 5kms we will find a small parking lot on the right just next to a footbridge. It is the parking for the Cova d'en Marc. We park		
Approach: (machine translated) By the path that goes to the cave, just upon arrival we will take the path to the right that zigzags back to the Forat de la Vella, here we find another path and we go left to continue climbing towards l'Airosa, the tributary. After 200m we will reach it and we will see a cairn that tells us where to go down to the riverbed.		
Tour: (machine translated) A first part more vertical in the tributary to descend to the bco d'en Marc. Here after rains we will find water so it will be necessary to wear neoprene. We will finish right in the Cova		
Return: (machine translated) Along the access path

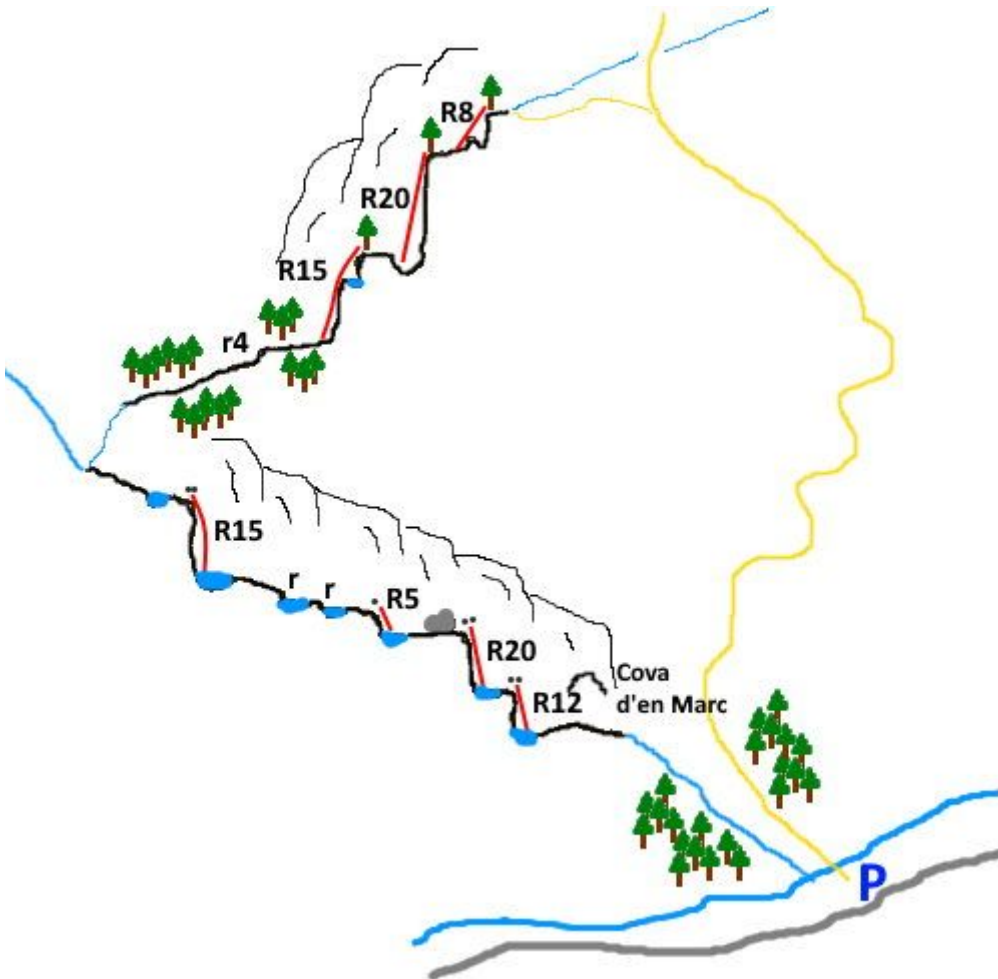
