1. from the church, climb up the watercourse in an easy scramble for about 1 hour until you reach a waterfall where it is not possible to climb up. It is a beautiful environment with some pools, jumps and topogans.
2. we start the canyon upstream, where there are many steps that make entry difficult - in total there are three more waterfalls than in option 1.
