Summary: (machine translated) Short canyon open and facing the sun		
Hydrology:		
Access: (machine translated) Leave the Italian freeway at Pontebba, cross the SS13 after the toll station and after about one kilometer you will be in the valley village of San Leopoldo, where you will find a gravel parking place directly under the freeway on the north bank of the Fella, at the eastern exit of the village.		
Approach: (machine translated) Pass under the highway onto the embankment of the cycle path. On the orographic left side of the canyon, a path begins directly from the cycle path over the bars of the slope protection. Keep right at the fork after about 40 meters. If you can't find it, try to gain height "cross-country" on the clearing of the old cable car route. At the latest on the ridge of the conquered hill you will find old canyons from which a recognizable path running northwest leads back down into the canyon. Historical background: this area was a NATO restricted military area until 2003. The cable car mountain station is clearly visible from the access path.		
Tour: (machine translated) The tour begins with a 40m rappel, followed by another 7 rappels < 25m. There are hardly any jumps or slides and you won't find any swimming sections here. Due to its southern orientation and openness, this canyon can be climbed early in the year.		
Return: (machine translated) At the exit of the tour you are back under the highway and it is not 5 min back to the parked car.
