Hydrology: (machine translated)

This valley is fed by springs, it rarely floods, but dries out at low water. Best explored at the beginning of the season.

Access: (machine translated)

Take the D2205 to Pont de Clans. Drive up to Clans, cross the village in the direction of "le cimetière" and continue along the slope to the "Pont Noir" (716 m) at the Monar. Park there.

Approach: (machine translated)

30 m after the bridge, a path on the left leads up to the path above.

Continue uphill, and 25 m before the tunnel a path leads up the rock face and then runs level to the depression.

Tour: (machine translated)

Two small jumps and arrival at the exit of the large waterfall. Insert 2 x 20 m ropes into the chute to reach the belay on the 50 m high wall.

To avoid an uninteresting part overgrown with undergrowth: At the foot of the waterfall, take a path on the left that leads onto the road. Follow this to the tarmac road and then descend back down into the valley.

Take the C12, C25 and C20 to Monar.

This weak section of the route disrupts the rhythm. There are only 2 x 150 m canyons left to tackle.

Accessible from Ratapénau.

You can drive up by car along the dirt road, but be careful not to park in the way, as this road is used by various vehicles, including timber trucks.

Return: (machine translated)

Climb 50 m up the Monar and follow small, barely recognizable paths to the car 100 m higher up.
