Drive up the Langevin river as far as Grand Galet. Follow the road to the end, where you will find a passable path that you must follow to the exit, where you can park your vehicles near a concrete cistern.

**Approach:** (machine translated)

Depending on your knowledge of the area and your physical condition, the hike can take between two and several hours.

Follow the path as far as Ti Cap. The path then crosses the watercourse, which you have to follow on the right bank, and then leads into a dry canyon, which you have to climb up for about 200 m until you reach a large boulder with three white colored spots. Turn right there and follow a path up to the ridge, the viewpoint on Cap Blanc, from where you have an overview of all the difficulties that await you. From the ridge, continue up before descending again. You will pass through a field of sabre-tooth leaves. Then enter the embankment at the foot of a small cliff and meander continuously through the canyon until you reach Bras des Mousses. Continue meandering to find the starting point of Cap Blanc. The destination can be recognized (from my memory) if you climb a little up the tributary to see the source (which is beautiful, by the way).

**Tour:** (machine translated)

The first clues set the tone, and a perfect assessment of the obstacles to be overcome as well as good knowledge and foresight are the key words for this course.

After the C56, a very strong counter-current follows on the C34, which keeps you under the waterfall in a small, harmless pool. The team can no longer see you or communicate with you. The leader must anticipate a sack throw to guide you.

Of course, don't forget the spit set!!!

At the pool with the return (R8, 34m) we sent one person without a rucksack ahead, who then helped the others out of the pool using a throw bag. The pool at the third-to-last rappel was no problem if you take the stance on the left. Despite the many tributaries, the mass of water/water force does not increase towards the exit of the rappel.
