Summary: (machine translated) Inflow to the Bendola with (C110 = 2x 55m)		
Hydrology: (machine translated) Certainly the tributary that receives the least water from the Bendola. After very heavy rainfall, when the Bendola has a very high water level, you can hope that Brever will carry water. It is then advisable to take the path from Baragne to the Castou bridge. Avoid going there too early in the season, as the snowfields in the canyon before the 110 m high point can be very problematic and the path to the upper parking lot may be closed. No marked emergency exits before the 8th hour in the canyon. Step 1 equipment to consider (2 points for large waterfalls), otherwise single point equipment.		
Access: (machine translated) Downhill parking lot: at marker 161 at the beginning of the path that leads to the Castou bridge (same parking lot as for the Bendola) Parking lot uphill: drive to the barracks of the parking lot uphill of the Bendola and follow the path to the Bertrand pass.		
Approach: (machine translated) From Col Bertrand, take the PR (yellow markings) to Pas de l'Incise. (There are a few forks, check the IGN map so as not to go off track). From the Pas de l'Incise, it is best to descend to the right on the fairly steep grassy slopes to reach one of the arms of the Brever (C30, bypassable on the right on the left bank of the river or AN at altitude), to then enter the Brever and go straight to the start of the first C45 (equipped).		

Tour: (machine translated)

Ascents and descents, interrupted by rappels, then a beautiful canyon with several small rappels to be tackled one after the other to reach the C110.

The C110 can be climbed in two pitches of about 55 m (intermediate belay RD on platform, beware of falling rocks).

Allow three hours to get to the foot of the 110 m, then 20 minutes to Nonorasque and another 40 minutes to Bendola, just below the Bois des Ours. Then allow three hours to reach the Baragne footbridge (possible emergency exit) and another two hours to reach the Castou bridge.

Canyon requires good physical condition, can be done in one day if you set off early and expect to return late.

Return: (machine translated)

From the Castou bridge, take the path up to the car. You can rest for 2 minutes, then you just have to get the car from the parking lot at the top.
