Upper part: from the settlement of Mayrhofen to the road bridge of the B161.

Lower part: from the road bridge to the Rettenbach settlement.

The upper part can be skipped: lots of walking terrain and few to hardly any interesting spots.

There are several abseiling points in the lower part, but overall the canyon is more for collectors.
