Access:

As with the Karnergraben: From the orographic left bank of Kufstein (train station), take the L37 to Vorderthiersee (a good 6 km). Continue on the L37 to Landl (7.5 km). Turn left here, over the Thierseer Ache and 5.2 km up to Riedenberg. Park your car here (residents complain, not on the turning area at the exit of the passable road). Perhaps better at the Gasthaus Wastler - if open, ask in advance and announce a stop for refreshments after the tour).

Access to Landl also via Schliersee, Bayrischzell.

Approach:

First follow the access path to the Karnergraben: We take the field path across the meadows in a south-westerly direction. The path gradually turns north and we reach a forest road. Follow this for 150m to the left until you reach the bridge over the Karnertalbach stream. Here we follow the forest road in the direction of Thaleralm. As we leave the forest, we see the Törleralm on the right above us.

Turn left here (westwards) downhill in the hollow to reach the entry to the lower part at 1100m altitude.

To reach the upper entry point, follow the piste towards Thaleralm. At a path with a Christ figure on a brick cube, we then descend northwestwards to the stream.

Tour:

2 parts, each of which can be walked separately. See also the video and photos.

In contrast to the description in Riml/Amor, we did not enter via the right side trench, but a little further up directly into the Törlergraben. We set 3 new anchors for the additional 5 rappels (the 2 others from the tree).

Return:

(machine translated)
We cross the Ellbach and then take the path that leads in an easterly direction along the Ellbach (Riedenberger Wiesenstraße). We keep to the Ellbach and finally cross the Karnergraben. This way we come back up to Riedenberg.
