Dam and water drainage above. Largely overgrown in the narrow passages

Access: (machine translated)

On the B158 from Bad Ischl to Strobl. Before Strobl, turn right towards Schwarzenbach. Large parking lot at the junction to Rußbach.

If you really want to shuttle, you can follow the signs to Schwarzensee, but you won't save any time.

#### **Approach:** (machine translated)

Shortly along the road to the bridge over the Schwarzenbach, then follow the hiking trail signs to the left towards Wirersteig. Before the end of the gorge, turn right up the steps. Follow the path until it leads back to the flatter terrain above the canyon. Follow the path down to the stream, which you reach just above the waterfall.

A 30m waterfall, then a beautiful gorge which is completely overgrown. Most of the rappels are made on bolts, but there are also at least two bolts. The gorge exits with a short swimming passage in front of the power station.
