| Access: (machine translated) Take the Faido highway exit. Take the main road towards Faido and turn right at point 706 towards the campsite. From there continue to the last waterfall. There are no suitable parking spaces near the canyon, so ask for permission before parking your car. Alternatively, park on the main road. | | |
| Approach: (machine translated) Relatively quick and easy on foot from Fasnengo. Follow the old mule track (Vecchia Mulattiera) and turn right at the crossroads next to point 802 onto the flat path towards the stream. The canyon begins at the steel bridge. The upper parts of the canyon may not have been drilled yet. Entry here would be at the bridge at 1074 hm. | | |
| Tour: (machine translated) First flat and easy, then increasingly vertical. A quick succession of rappels. | | |
| Return: (machine translated) At the bridge where the water level was checked orographically right out of the stream to the road, follow this to the right to the car. | | |
