Summary: (machine translated)

Beautiful canyon not suitable for novices unless you go in summer. Very continuous and dressed, it will be a discovery at the foot of the port of San Isidro.

Hydrology:

Access: (machine translated)

Along the road that goes up to the San Isidro pass AS253 / AS112.

We will pass Felechosa and Cuevas, around the p.k. 34 we have a lay-by on the left (ascending to the pass), "El Carrozal" where we will park.

Approach: (machine translated)

In front of us there is a small path that descends to a track that crosses the San Isidro River and heads towards the mountain. Soon it becomes a winding path that goes up, through a dense forest, on the orographic right of our descent. At an altitude of 1100m, inside this beautiful beech forest, we will leave the trail and go to the right to enter the river.

Tour: (machine translated)

Without rest, rappels of between 10 and 30m that have their culmination in the 6th, a nice narrowing that collects all the water in the area. Caution at this point if the flow is high, in which case it is almost better to descend from a tree on the left to avoid the active. After this a few more rappels to finish descending to the lower plain.

Return: (machine translated)

We will leave to the left to a path that leads us to a half-abandoned track, from the shepherds' huts that will take us to a small bridge to cross the San Isidro River and reach the access track, we will take it to the right to find the path that leads us up to the road.
