**Access:** (machine translated)

From Biasca in the direction of "Val Leventina". Direction Bodio, in Bodio direction Giornico. Approx. half a kilometer after the railroad bridge, cross the river on the left. Cross a second bridge, then turn right. Take the next left under the highway and park a little further on the right.

**Approach:** (machine translated)

From the car, follow the road northwards until a path branches off after a few houses and heads steadily uphill towards Catto. After a few meters the path winds very steeply in serpentine up the slope. After the hairpin bends, the path climbs only slightly along the slope and no longer steeply uphill through Catto to a bridge that spans the Cramosina. After the bridge, descend steeply to the left in a small arc to the stream.

**Tour:** (machine translated)

Sequence of five high abseils. Can only be climbed when dry. Emergency exit after the first c60 orographic right. Best done after heavy rain so that everything is washed out.

**Return:** (machine translated)

From the stream approx. 100 m to the road/car.
