From Braga on the N 103 (east) towards Chaves. After 45 km you reach Ruivaes. If you have a second car, park it about 3 km before Ruivaes on the N 103, where a dirt road comes up from the bottom left, see map at https://www.docuwiki.infobarrancos.es/doku.php?id=portugal:braga:saltadouro

#### Approach: (machine translated)

At the exit of the right-hand bend, where the upper vehicle is parked at the edge of the N 103, a small paved road goes down to the left. This meets a similar road coming up from the right. Follow the latter on the left (in a south-westerly direction) down to the stone bridge over the Saltadouro (entry on the left).

#### **Tour:** (machine translated)

In the chaos at the exit, the rappel anchors are not always easy to find; twice you rappel on rope slings through narrow holes into cavities below.

## Return: (machine translated)

Turn left at the bridge. If you have parked a second car, follow the dirt road to the left (in a southerly direction) up to the N 103; if you only have the car in Ruivaes, follow the dirt road to the right over the bridge in a northerly direction until you come to a small road that leads up to Ruivaes, see map section in https://www.docuwiki.infobarrancos.es/doku.php?id=portugal:braga:saltadouro.

(In fact, all the anchors are on the right.) Fierce dogs on the way back. Fun otherwise. :)
