Summary: (machine translated) A wild canyon in relatively dense vegetation with moss at the waterfalls, over which a trickle of water flows. 6 rappels		
Hydrology: (machine translated) A short, well-equipped canyon with numerous emergency exits.		
Access: (machine translated) Road from Ainsa to Bielsa. Leave your car in the parking lot at the left-hand entrance to Bielsa.		
Approach: (machine translated) Cross the Cinca bridge and turn right immediately after the bridge onto the path signposted "Ibon del Cau". Follow this path and just before reaching the canyon, turn left through a "rustic gate" consisting of a metal bed frame. From there, climb up the hill on the right bank of the canyon until you reach an uninhabited house. Unmarked section of path in sparse vegetation. Go around the house on the right to reach the beginning of the canyon.		
Tour: (machine translated) A wild canyon in relatively dense vegetation with moss on the waterfalls, over which a trickle of water flows. The canyon has 6 well-secured rappels, the longest of which measures 25 m, as well as parts where it may be necessary to attach a rope traverse to natural anchor points. (Beware of the numerous dead trees and bushes on the banks).		
Return: (machine translated) Follow the clearly recognizable path that leads back to the Cinca bridge in a few minutes

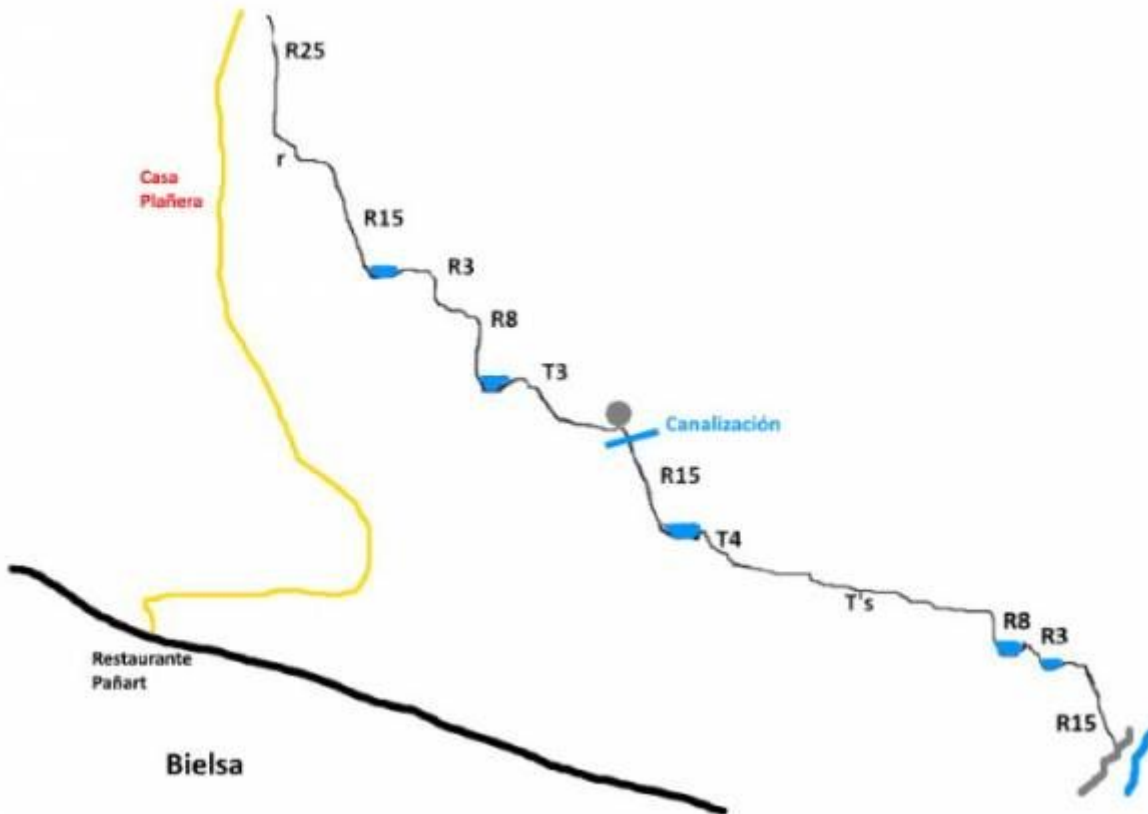
