Summary: (machine translated) Beautiful, short vertical canyon without trail; half-day tour; well combinable with Kargraben, Rothmannbach or Weißbach; limestone and dolomite rock; despite the name clean water ;-); about 1.5Km ² catchment area; well equipped; stands were renewed in 2017; exposure south; €3,- trail maintenance fee if shuttle car at Kugelmühle; some narrow places.		
Hydrology:		
Access: (machine translated) 10min+10min 1. possibility with shuttle car: From Salzburg south you drive in the direction of Berchtesgaden. After the village Marktschellenberg there is a long straight. At the exit of the straight you have to cross a small bridge (Königseeache) to Kugelmühle/Almbach where you park the shuttle car. With the 2nd car you drive back to the village Marktschellenberg. At the church (crossroads) turn left and follow the mountain road towards Ettenberg. 50m after the large parking lot for hikers (Neuhäusel) turn right. Here man has right at 2 wooden huts a few parking possibilities (Otherwise large parking lot). 2nd possibility: See exit/return. (From the parking exit follow the hiking signs "Ettenberg via Talgrabenweg". From here continue left up to the road. Then turn left back to the parking entry.		
Approach: (machine translated) 10min From the parking lot near the 2 wooden huts, follow the forest road (no driving sign) on the right over a small bridge. Immediately after the bridge go left and next to the stream downhill to another junction with a wooden hut. Turn left again and continue downhill until you reach a weekend house. Do not cross the private property here, but enter the stream beforehand (approx. 750m).		

Tour: (machine translated)

1-1,5h

Just after the house comes the 1st 15m abseil. Quickly the canyon narrows. After a few steps follow the next 4 rappelling points which are all directly in the water. At higher water levels, the steps can quickly become problematic! Especially the belaystation after the 3rd rappel (C5) is on the left behind the rock face and should only be reached with a rope. From here you already have a beautiful view into the Almbach. After the 4th abseil (approx. 15m) it becomes more open again. A rappel of about 40m to the chain anchor follows. The 2 following 40m and 35m steps can be divided optionally. After the last rappel point, you are almost at the hiking trail from the Almbach at about 600m.

Return: (machine translated)

approx. 40min

Depending on where you parked your car, you can either follow the path next to the Almbachklamm gorge downhill to the parking lot (Überstellungsfahrzeug) at the Kugelmühle. Or follow the path only briefly to the hiking sign "Ettenberg via Talgrabenweg". From here continue up to the left until you reach the road. Then turn left back to the parking entry.

Tip: On the way back to the Kugelmühle, there are a few beautiful pools at the exit of the Almbachklamm gorge that invite you to jump if the water level/depth is right.

Anchors are fine. Quite a few singles and unlinked though. Grippy rock. Tree still in first abseil. Abseil 3 is into a pool, you can stand, but it is deep, and in high flows it could be pretty exciting! Abseil 5 - bring double 50m rope if you don't like downclimbing.

Very nice short tour. Condition of the anchors very good. Lots of wood in the water right at the start. Rock with good grip. Thin neo was sufficient. We returned via the hiking trail, about 50 minutes at a very relaxed pace (machine translated)

The rock was very grippy thanks to the high water. All belays were in top condition. Some were a bit loose, but were tightened again. At the beginning of the tour you have to fight your way through some wood and it's not the longest tour, but in the sunshine it's a very nice tour with beautiful rappels. It could possibly be combined with the Almbach gorge, but we climbed straight back up to the starting point (car). Price for the Almbach gorge (hiking trails) currently €8 (machine translated)
