<b>Access:</b> (machine translated) From Bilbao via Santander to Oviedo. Continue on the N-634 in the (western) direction of Grado or Cornellana. After 12 km turn south towards Trubia and go up the river of the same name (19 km) to Proaza. Here turn left towards Villamejin and in the village keep left towards San Martin. Continue in the direction of Serandi. At the following bridge over the Rio Serandi park the car.		
<b>Approach:</b> (machine translated) About 30 m east of the bridge, a path leaves the tarred road. This crosses the Rio Serandi at a dilapidated mill on the orographic left bank and climbs up in switchbacks as an old mule track. You then meet the path coming from San Martin (old access). After about 50 minutes you reach a meadow, pass the stone house on the left and descend in an easterly direction to the stream. Here is the entry.		
<b>Tour:</b> (machine translated) 18 rapel. The upper narrowly cut part in the semi-darkness is worth the effort (especially the exit).At the end of a more open middle section still come the two long rapel. Several times there may be opportunities for slides and smaller jumps.		
<b>Return:</b> (machine translated) After the last rappelling point, continue walking in the streambed for a few hundred meters until the tracks to the left lead to the ascent path (approx. 100 m before the dilapidated mill). Follow it downhill and back to the car.		
<b>Coordinates:</b> Canyon Start <a href="#">43.2453 -5.9837</a> Canyon End <a href="#">43.2486 -5.9922</a>
