We can leave at exit 20 to take the GC291 or exit 15 also towards the GC291 or the GC751 to San Felipe.

On the GC291, at km 2 we have the bridge over the Moya ravine, there is a place to park the return vehicle.

With the access vehicle we continue until the p.k. 4.2 in Farailaga, turn off to Tres Palmas, we go up for 1 km until we pass a small reservoir and reach a fork (Desaguaderos and Lomo de Vergara), at that point we turn left until the end of the road.
