Summary: (machine translated) Wild, often dry or low-water canyon. This part ends at a concrete weir with water drainage		
Hydrology:		
Access: (machine translated) From Moggio Udinese up into the Aupa valley. Turn right to Pardis and follow the road further up the mountain. Turn right at a junction. Parking possibility in front of barriers at about 1050m.		
Approach: (machine translated) The path "540" begins to the right of the information board and heads NW. The first part has been closed since 2024 due to a landslide, continue briefly on the road, then take the sand road to the right (marked). Follow the hiking trail until you reach a saddle after 1h45min. A few meters below the saddle, a small path begins that leads south to a dilapidated hut. Continue south, descending pathlessly through the forest until you reach a dry streambed.		
Tour: (machine translated) First descent in the dry streambed (possibly tree rappels). Then 4 rappels before you stand in front of 55m break. Securing exposed and high attached - handrail stretch over clamping block. Under the waterfall another rappel before it goes over many downclimbs (including small jumps & slides) to the dam. In this area you meet the remains of two wooden huts.		
Return: (machine translated) Continue through the canyon or break off via the path branching off to the right at the dam. This path is exposed in sections and slipped in one place. It leads in about 50 min. to the power station at Rio Alba and further in 30min. to the access road.
