<b>Summary:</b> (machine translated) A waterfall approx. 80 m (35 / 45)		
<b>Hydrology:</b> (machine translated) Light stream that probably only carries water directly after rainfall.		
<b>Access:</b> (machine translated) By car to the paid parking lot at the exit of the Kiental (at the exit of the Griesschlucht)		
<b>Approach:</b> (machine translated) From the Tschingelsee, follow the Bärenpfad in the direction of Griesalp / Golderli. The well-maintained hiking trail first leads steeply uphill and then crosses a small bridge over a stream. Continue on the path until you see a conspicuous building on the meadow on the right (downhill). Walk across the meadow to the edge of the forest, where you meet the small stream just before the slope. Continue to follow the stream.		
<b>Tour:</b> (machine translated) For the last few meters to the edge, hang a rope from a tree and use it to descend secured to the last suitable tree. Use another tree as a natural anchor and rappel from there for about 80 meters. An intermediate stand can be set up after approx. 35 meters (in the water!) - but it is unlikely to find suitable anchors here.		
<b>Return:</b> (machine translated) 230 meters across the meadows to the parking lot
