ACCESS: from the locality "al lago" at km 1.2 of the S.P.56 Canal San Bovo-Caoria, take the ENEL path directly from the house in front of the parking lot and follow it comfortably to the water intake (beginning of the lower part) in about twenty minutes. Now continue to the right on a clearly visible path, following the red markings, until below the last waterfall of the upper part, where you cross the stream, continue along a chute, always faithfully following the red markings, after this rather uncomfortable part, take a nice ledge on the right that leads to a collar from which you can see the upper part of the canyon. From here, go around a chute and then traverse towards the stream on the right (red markings) to reach the start of the canyon slightly downhill, right at the first beautiful 25 m high waterfall. (50 min - 1 hour).

The most beautiful and branchy part is the upper section with 14 abseiling points and 250 m difference in altitude. This is followed by an intermediate section up to the water inlet, which affects the flow. In the lower part, although with very little water, there are some beautiful verticals in a worked granite environment (80 m drop). The well-known via ferrata runs through the lower part. At some points after the highest anchor you can clip into the climbing harnesses.
