Like (lower) Seinsbachklamm: From Garmisch-Partenkirchen (town center, central intersection) 17.4 km on the B 2 in the direction of Mittenwald, Innsbruck. At the Isarhorn campsite, turn left off the B 2 before the (second) bridge over the Isar, take the second small road to the left in the direction of Ferein-Alm and follow the orographic right bank of the Seinsbach for 300 m in a northerly direction. There is plenty of space to park at the next fork in the forest road.

Approach: (machine translated)

First as (lower) Seinsbachklamm: Continue on the forest road towards Ferein-Alm. After about 25 minutes and 900 m we take the forest road to the right in the direction of Aschaualm, Mittenwald and after another 5 minutes we reach the Seinsbach (970 m above sea level).\nWe continue on the dirt road in the direction of Mittenwald. After approx. 300 m, we turn left at a sharp angle in front of a chapel (Aschauer Kapelle). Before the farmstead (Aschauer Alm), take the 'hunters path' uphill to the right. After about 15 minutes you cross a stream (which flows into the Seinsbach directly below the waterfall) and come to the edge of a slope with a resting bench. Here, at about 1100 m above sea level, we take a footpath from the hunters path on the left horizontally before the next left turn (see photo!). After a few meters to the right around the edge of the slope, we reach another slope edge (GPS: N 47' 28' 21.01 / E 11' 18' 9.72), on which we descend without a path to the stream. After a few meters down the stream we come to the waterfall.\n

Tour: (machine translated)

With a little skill, you can stay out of the powerful stream on the right. After the rappel, you walk a few more meters in a gulch-like gorge before it widens and we come back to the bridge over the Seinsbach in the open gravel bed.

Return: (machine translated)

Either get off at the bridge on the right and walk back along the ascent path or - normally - continue along the lower Seinsbachklamm gorge to its exit (see description there).
